























The Page Builder panel is organized into 4 main content types that can be dragged to the Stage

Appearance










How the Design System impacts the theme?

Page Builder theme has always the same organization:





What about styles organization?

Page Builder is a module, its main style file is web/css/source/_module.less Use this file to merge your content type styles into the pub/static output with all the other module styles

//_module.less

[...]

@import '_icons.less'; @import '_layout.less'; @import 'slick/_slick.less'; @import 'content-type/_import.less';

[...]

_import.less

Orchestrate the merge of all your content type styles

Each content type has its own __import.less to merge each appearance styles









Where can you find a part of the Page Builder theme?

module-pagebuilder (core)

view/adminhtml

 \rightarrow all default admin theme \rightarrow all default storefront render templates

view/frontend

 \rightarrow all default storefront styles

<Vendor>/<theme>

web/css/source

 \rightarrow override of default storefront styles

<Vendor>/<module

view/adminhtml

- \rightarrow customization of default admin theme
- → customization of default storefront render templates → styles of admin new extension or content type

view/frontend


 \rightarrow extend of all default storefront styles \rightarrow styles of storefront new extension or content type






Creating admin templates

- preview.html vs master.html
- Directory name must match appearance name
- Use default for content types with only one appearance
- block
 default
 master.html
 preview.html

Example: template for banner on your storefront






Step 1 – Create an extension module







Step 2 – Extend Appearances




Like layout files, Page Builder configuration files are merged
